At Portsmouth Darts Academy we want you to enjoy your sessions as you practice and improve your darts game.

To enable this, there are a few things we'd like you to know;

- It's important to follow our Code of Conduct at all times
- You are encouraged to follow the Dart Etiquette we've provided
- If you ever have any concerns, or complaints, you should feel comfortable to approach any PDA coach
- You can do this during a session, or after a session has finished
- If you feel that someone is behaving inappropriately towards you, we would encourage you to do one or more of the following;
 - Tell a friend
 - Tell a coach
 - Tell an adult you feel you can trust
 - Write your concern down. Leave it in the Academy welcome area (where Laura registers you at the beginning of each session)
 - Tell your parent or guardian
 - Visit our website at portsmouthdartsacademy.co.uk and fill in the Feedback & Complaints form.
- Remember that the purpose of the JDC challenge routine is for you to improve YOUR game. It is not a competition against other Academy members
- Support other academy members – be positive about their games, help them when they need it, stick together
- Be inclusive when new members join. Introduce yourself, and include them in your groups and games
- Fully participate, try your hardest and listen to your coaches
- Understand that occasionally you'll be off your game, which could be for any reason. Recognise that this happens, understand it's not a bad thing, and resolve to try again
